Background

More than 5 hundred exhibitors will be participating in the program and five hundred thousand visitors will

The event will be the venue for exchanging not only the goods and services but also the culture, sentiments and relationship build up with the business people of Nepal and neighboring countries like Indian, China, Bhutan and Bangladesh. Beside these many more recreational and adventures events will be the extra concentration of the event.

Chitwan Mahotsav, the biannual event has played a key role in protecting and enhancing the economic activities of Chitwan district and inspired the local entrepreneurs to put forth their best in a grand display of their skills, entrepreneurship and competence.
